Teachers and community members are welcome to attend for their own benefit and in support of Junior Pro Art and its members. There are no annual dues to participate in JPA 2008-2009; however, a \$5 student members' fee is appreciated at each event to defray costs.

Events are held at the First Unitarian Universalist Society of Syracuse, located at the corner of Waring and Nottingham Roads, on the proposed Sundays listed below at 7 p.m. Generally, each event will include not only performance opportunities but also interactive topics of musical interest lead by masters in our community. Performers may bring their own accompanist; however, JPA has arranged to have one present at each event for your benefit and convenience with no additional fee. The accompanist must be provided a copy of the music at least four days in advance of any event. Students wishing to perform should arrive by 6:45 p.m. and sign in for performance on a first-come, first-served basis. If students are not able to perform due to time constraints, they will have priority at the next event (excluding the anticipated masterclass with Maestro Daniel Hege in May). Performance and optional critical feedback time is limited to 15 minutes per student.
